STORY	Group Enoport United Wines unified some of the oldest and most well-known Portuguese wine estates. Among them is Caves Velhas, located in the Tejo region and established in 1939, who is an anchor in the portfolio for its commitment to tradition and quality. Quinta de S. João Batista sits on a colonial estate in the Bairro area of Tejo and is comprised of 97 hectares of vineyards planted with native Portuguese and international varietals. This estate combines the best of traditional viticulture and modern winemaking technology. Enoport commitment to winemaking excellent was recognized in 2012 as European Winery of the Year by Mundus Vini.
